## Concert Scale Assignments Term I

1. Record your name and your grade level.
2. Play your major scale saying the name of the scale before you play it. Listen to your recording before you submit it. Send only your best “take.” All scales should be played in quarter notes at tempo 120. Tongue each note of the scale.

Freshmen: Record the following scales only: Concert Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, C and F.

Sophomores: Record the following scales only: Concert Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, Gb, G, C, and F.

Juniors: Record all major scales in the following order: Concert Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, Gb, B, E, A, D, G, C, F.

Seniors: Record Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, C, & F concert major scales then play g, c, f, b-flat, a, & d concert minor scales.

3. Percussion: It is in your best interest to be as proficient on mallets/keyboard instruments as possible. If you do not have a bell kit or piano/keyboard at home, you will be assigned a snare rudiment for each scale. Please let me know if you require this option.

\*Points are deducted for not following the recording procedures. Be sure to listen to your recording completely before turning in the assignment.
